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REGULATIONS on the INTERUNIVERSITY SUBJECT OLYMPIAD in LANGUAGE DISCIPLINES

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1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1. The Interuniversity Subject Olympiad in language disciplines among 1st and 2nd year students (here in after referred to as the Olympiad) is held by the Kazakh and Foreign Languages Section of the Department of Social and Humanitarian Disciplines of the Kurmangazy Kazakh National Conservatory (here in after referred to as the Conservatory) in order to ensure the quality of teaching language subjects and identify gifted, creative-minded students.

2. This Regulation was developed on the basis of the order of the Ministry of Education and Science of the Republic of Kazakhstan "On approval of the List of republican and international Olympiads and competitions of scientific projects (scientific competitions) in general subjects, competitions of performers, competitions of professional skills and sports competitions and criteria for their selection" (dated December 7, 2011 No. 514) and the Charter of the Conservatory (dated 12.09.2022 No. 53).

2. GOALS AND OBJECTIVES OF THE OLYMPIAD

3. The purpose of the Olympiad is to motivate students to study state and foreign languages; to develop communicative competence in the totality of its components – speech, language, socio-cultural, compensatory, educational and cognitive; to organize and conduct independent and objective control of the level of formation of skills and abilities in various types of speech activity.

4. Tasks of the Olympiad:

- 1) Identification and development of students' creative abilities, interest in the studied disciplines and research activities;
- 2) Promotion of scientific knowledge, improvement of extracurricular work with students; development of cooperation with educational organizations;
- 3) Creation of the necessary conditions for the support of gifted students, including assistance in their intellectual development; realization of the educational potential of participants;
- 4) Ensuring monitoring of the level of proficiency of students of various groups in state and foreign languages.

3. TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE OLYMPIAD

5. The Olympiad is held in an offline format on the basis of Kurmangazy Kazakh National Conservatory.

6. Students of the 1st, 2nd courses of all specialties of Kurmangazy Kazakh National Conservatory can take part in the Olympiad and other universities (teaching students of creative specialties) in Almaty.

7. The Olympiad is held in the following subjects:

- Kazakh language
- Russian language
- English

8. The Olympiad is held annually in March - April;

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9. The number of participants is determined by the teachers of the discipline in which the Olympiad is held. University students studying this discipline can take part in the Olympiad at will;

10. The jury of the Olympiad is formed from representatives of the teaching staff of the Kazakh and Foreign Languages section of the Department of Social and Humanitarian Disciplines of Kurmangazy Kazakh National Conservatory and language disciplines teachers of other universities (teaching students of creative specialties) in Almaty;

11. Participants who have won prizes are awarded with diplomas of I, II and III degrees; certificates are issued to all participants and managers.

12. The deadline for submitting applications for participation in the Olympiad expires 10 calendar days before the start of the Olympiad;

4. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE ORGANIZERS

13. To organize and conduct the Olympiad by order of the rector conservatory approves the composition of the organizing committee, which determines the general order of the Olympiad;

14. The list of jury members and responsible persons for each subject are determined by the organizing committee of the Olympiad and approved by the order of the rector;

15. The Interuniversity subject Olympiad in language disciplines is held in accordance with the developed Regulations on the interuniversity subject Olympiad;

16. The organizers of the Olympiad and the subject teachers are responsible for the timely preparation of the materials of the Olympiad and compliance with the deadlines.

5. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF THE JURY MEMBERS

17. A member of the Jury has the right to request additional information necessary for the evaluation of the participants of the Olympiad, as well as to express and defend his opinion in a reasoned manner during the evaluation of the participants and the selection of the winners of the Olympiad;

18. A member of the Jury is obliged to analyze the materials and speeches submitted by the participants of the Olympiad for compliance with the requirements for the participants of the Olympiad;

19. A member of the Jury is personally responsible for the competence of the assessment and the objectivity of the points awarded.

6. RIGHTS AND OBLIGATIONS OF PARTICIPANTS

20. Participants have the right to receive information about the terms and conditions of the Olympiad.

21. A participant of the Olympiad may be suspended from participation in the Olympiad for violating the order of the Olympiad in the relevant subject;

22. The participants of the Olympiad are obliged to comply with this Regulation, perform all actions related to participation in the Olympiad.

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7. REQUIREMENTS FOR THE PARTICIPANTS OF THE OLYMPIAD

23. The Olympiad by the discipline "Kazakh language" includes two

rounds:

I – Oral communication of the participant (representatives of another nationality, non-native speakers) in the form of a summary on a given topic selected by tickets (10 topics are provided to students in advance for familiarization). The message should be succinct, clearly and clearly convey the essence of the topic of the speech. The main task of the message is to convey certain information without going beyond the given topic.

The performance time is 3-4 minutes.

II - Preparation of a presentation and presentation on the topic: "Music is the universal language of mankind."

The content of the work: the role of music in human life and society. Music as a universal expression of ideas, emotions, feelings in different human cultures, a means of bringing together people of different nationalities, faiths and views. Protection of the main idea of the work.

The performance time is 5-7 minutes.

24. The Olympiad by the discipline "Russian language" includes two rounds:

I – Oral communication of the participant (students of the Kazakh department) in the form of a summary on a given topic selected by tickets (10 topics are provided to students in advance for familiarization). The message should be succinct, clearly and clearly convey the essence of the topic of the speech. The main task of the message is to convey certain information without going beyond the given topic. II - Preparation of a presentation and presentation on the topic: "Music is the universal language of mankind."

The content of the work: the role of music in human life and society. Music as a universal expression of ideas, emotions, feelings in different human cultures, a means of bringing together people of different nationalities, faiths and views. Protection of the main idea of the work.

The performance time is 5-7 minutes.

25. The Olympiad in the discipline "English language" includes two rounds:

I - Lexico-grammatical test consisting of 30 tasks (contains the vocabulary of music art). The test is performed in on-line mode in the program "Kahoot".

The time allotted for completing tasks should not exceed 30 minutes.

II - Presentation on "Music is the universal language of mankind". Preparation of a presentation in English with concrete examples (including examples concerning the personality of the contestant) that music plays an important role in the community of peoples, thanks to its emotional influence performs an ideological, cultural, educational and aesthetic function, is a means of communication that illustrates in sound form the feelings of a person, his emotions, willpower.

The time limit of the presentation in the second round: 3 - 5 minutes.

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26. Requirements for the participant:

1. An original and non-standard approach to the disclosure of the topic;
2. Expressing one's own opinions within the framework of a given topic, free form of presentation;
3. Completing test tasks in the allotted time;
4. Speech and presentation using technical means (computer, interactive whiteboard);
5. Defense of the main idea and intent of the speech, evidence-based presentation of your vision of the issue.
6. Logically correct, clear, competent style of presentation;
7. The content of the speech.

8. SUMMING UP, AWARDING OF PARTICIPANTS

27. The results of the Olympiad are summed up by a jury in each discipline consisting of members of the commission;
28. The winners of the Olympiad are awarded 1st, 2nd, 3rd place;
29. All participants are issued certificates of participants;
30. Additional encouragement of participants for the best performance is possible;
31. The decisions of the jury on disciplines are final and are not subject to revision.

9. PROCEDURE FOR MAKING CHANGES

32. Proposals to amend these Regulations are discussed at a meeting of the Academic Council and are accepted or canceled by a majority vote;
33. Amendments to the Regulations are made only by the decision of the Academic Council of the Conservatory on the basis of an official letter from the head of the educational and methodological department, agreed with the Vice-rector for Academic and methodological work;
34. Amendments to the Regulation are made in accordance with the requirements of the QMS with a mandatory mark in the "Change Registration List".

10. FINAL PROVISIONS

35. This Regulation, as well as amendments and additions to it, are approved by the Rector of the Conservatory and come into force after their approval.
36. The provisions of the Regulation are binding and may be amended or supplemented in connection with changes in regulatory documents.
